Budget

Current Plan

Current Budget-We are on track with our budget for this year's plan.

2015-2016 Plan/Budget-Colleen will survey teachers for ideas for next year's plan. Parents will think and/or search other plans to get ideas of what they'd like for next year's plan. We will discuss this in February.

An email was sent to the SCC earlier in January (January 13-14) to request input on adjusting money in some of the accounts in our Trustland plan. The SCC all voted in favor of the changes by email. See the text of the email below.

1. We budgeted \$3750 for substitutes for the DRA to be given last summer to students before school started and for substitutes for some conferences.

Upper grade teachers did not end up giving the DRA before school started. We would like to transfer \$500 from this account to supplies to help our teachers purchase supplies for science. (Science supplies were in our original plan. Based on grade level needs, we'd like to put additional money here.)

2. We budgeted \$12,871 for aides for Double Dosing and classroom support.

We didn't start our programs as early as we had planned. We were going to increase aide time in our classrooms, but are having a difficult time scheduling more aide time into the day and finding additional people. We would like to move \$2,000 from this account into supplies for the reasons stated in #1.

3. We budgeted \$6,250 for substitutes this year.

We changed the format of our Watch Me Wednesdays which has decreased the number of substitute teachers that we need. We would live to move \$1,000 from this account into supplies for the reason stated in #1.

We have also been given an opportunity to purchase student access for \$.50/student to a data bank of higher-level thinking questions. These are sorted by standard and objective as well as by "Depth of Knowledge" level, which we are working on this year. (Increasing higher-level thinking.) I spoke to several team leaders and we feel this would be a good opportunity for our students and teachers to have access to these questions before the price increases to \$3.00/student next year. This would come from supply money.
