Application Process

- 1. Learn about Chinese Immersion by attending a parent information meeting at the school (**January 20, 6:00 7:00 p.m.**), or from information on the school's web page: http://blackridge.alpineschools.org.
- 2. Submit a *Chinese Immersion Program Application Form* to Black Ridge Elementary School (9358 N Sunset Dr, Eagle Mountain, UT 84005) by **4:00 p.m.**, **February 26**, **2016**. Applications are available on the school's web page (see above) or a hard copy at the school beginning January 29, 2016. If mailing your application, please include a self-addressed, stamped envelope to receive a dated copy of the application.
- 3. Obtain a dated copy of your application from the school. Your dated copy is your confirmation of receipt of your application. It is your responsibility to confirm with the school that the application was received.
- 4. Watch for notification of your child's selection for the program by **March 18, 2016**. If you do not receive it by **March 21, 2016**, please call Reon Cowan at 801-610-8729.
- 5. If your child is selected for the program, return the *Parent Commitment and Registration Forms* and *Out-of-Area Transfer Form* (where applicable) by **March 30, 2016** to confirm participation. For families living outside of the school's attendance boundaries, parents must submit an *Out-of-Area Transfer Form* for each sibling they would like to also attend Black Ridge Elementary.
- 6. A Fall Student and Parent Orientation will be held before school begins in August.

Conditions for Placement in the Chinese Immersion Program

This application does not guarantee enrollment in the program. Students will be selected by the following process:

School and district personnel will determine the number of spaces that will be available for students enrolled at Cascade Elementary, as well as the number of spaces for students not currently enrolled and requesting an out-of-area transfer. The number of spaces available in each category is based on the enrollment needs of the school to maintain the traditional and dual immersion programs. If we have received more applications than available spots on **February 26**, **2016**, **at 4:00 p.m.**, a lottery will be used to determine placement in the program. Students with siblings already enrolled in the Chinese Immersion program and students with background in Chinese language will receive priority consideration.

If the child is selected to attend the dual immersion program, it is the responsibility of the parents to ensure consistent, punctual attendance by providing transportation to and from the school.

An immersion program is most effective when students remain in the program for a sustained period of time. Enrolled students are expected to continue with the program through 6th grade unless the family moves, or a school-parent team decision is made that it is in the best interest of the student to have a different placement.
