We are making progress toward our goal. Data from DIBELS and SAGE benchmark modules show that we are on track.

Teachers approve of the goal and the direction we are going.

Get a topic/title list of books in guided reading library. Kids really like Big Brainz (more than Reflex).

3. Ideas for 2017-2018 school goal

From teachers: Keep goal or raise the bar by a percentage. Action steps: Mastery Connect

Parents: Change for Double Dose (change to during the day, "amped" up Target Time, time for teachers to work with kids during the day and put an aide in their classes, hire teacher hourly) Early time for teachers and students is difficult.)

More ideas:

- *Activity based "rewards" (kids' names in drawings for reaching goals, physical reminders for reading, writing incentives-post office/writing and have students deliver as a job, pen pals, Book It, Jazz Reading)
- *Small goals as an action step (reward or brag tag)
- *Writing incentive right before SAGE
