At Foothill Elementary, we feel that keyboarding skills are very important. These skills prepare students for junior high and high school, as well as for working in the 21st Century. Students spend a few minutes practicing keyboarding in their Computer specialty class at school, but to really become proficient typers, students are encouraged to practice their typing skills at home. To reinforce and encourage students with this skill, we are excited to announce our first annual...

"Foothill Keyboarding Challenge"

Here is how it works:

- 1. By the end of each trimester, students in grades 3rd 6th will be asked to meet a benchmark.
- 2. Those who reach this grade-level benchmark (see below) will be given a small prize AND their names are entered into a drawing.
- 3. One student who met the benchmark will be randomly selected to win a brand-new **Chromebook!** One Chromebook will given away at the end of each trimester (Paid for with fundraiser funds).
- 4. At the end of the school year, the student with the fastest wpm in keyboarding from each grade, 3rd through 6th, will receive the "**Golden Mouse Award**." (This is a wireless, gold-colored computer mouse). If there is a tie, the student with the higher accuracy percentage wins.
- 5. Students take a typing test during the last few days of each trimester--typing speed tests from earlier in the year aren't counted for the contest.
