It offers a positive environment including music, art, student leadership, the Patriot Reading program, and Target Time, an intervention devoted to meeting students' various academic needs.

OPPORTUNITIES TO VOLUNTEER

- * Classroom volunteers - Our teachers welcome parent involvement in the classroom. There are volunteer opportunities including reading with or working with students, changing take home reading books, helping with special projects or activities (some that can be done from home).

A FOCUS ON READING!

At Forbes, our goal is to help all of our students acquire not only the ability to read, but also the love of reading.

This year we are focusing on reading skills as a primary goal of our School Improvement Plan. Our focus will be achieved in part using the following:

- * Trust Land funds are being used to update both the guided reading and take home reading libraries.
 - The guided reading library consists of book sets (5 to 6 copies of the same book) on specific reading levels that are used in the classroom with teacher guidance for literacy circles and classroom reading groups.
 - The Take Home Reading library provides books for students in lower grades to take home each night to encourage and increase reading skills. The books selected are on each student's individual reading level and encourage reading comprehension, accuracy, and fluency.
- * Teacher collaboration and professional development opportunities will allow teachers to focus on individual reading skills as well as allow them to laterally align reading skills between grade levels.
- * Target Time is a thirty-minute intervention block that takes place every Tuesday thru Thursday. The goal is to foster reading comprehension and fluency skills by allowing students in multiple classes in a grade to work collectively on their own skill level.
- * The PTA Sponsored Patriot Reading program will continue to provide support and encourage students to read. By supporting the newly designed program of the Patriot Reading committee, the PTA will support incentives and rewards that will encourage students at Forbes to set and record reading goals.

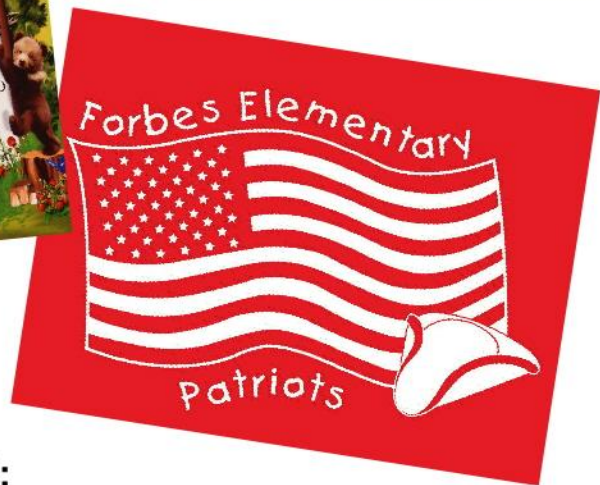

- * Student Leadership

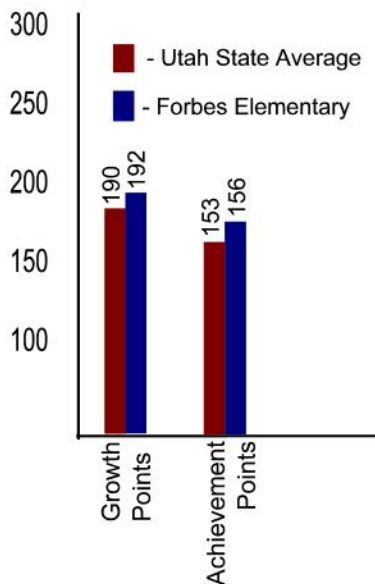


School Improvement Goal for 2014-2015:
