How do I get involved in the Research Challenge?

- ★ Pick a topic or ask a question you would like to investigate further
- * Research may be done individually, or by small groups of students working as a research team
- ★ Fill out the entry form
- ★ Turn your entry form into the Library
- ★ Start your research, investigate your question, collect your data and information, and create your research presentation
- ★ Research may be presented in any format you choose such as: audio report, video report, magazine article, written report, research poster (online or print), Google Slides, game, online book or print book, or some other creative presentation media
- ★ Everyone will be required to do a slideshow (via Google Slides). We can help you with that!
- ★ Dress up for your presentation (either in costume related to your topic or just professional)
- ★ Resources:
 - <u>Content Experts:</u> Identify people in the community who are experts in your area of research.
 Contact them about questions you have.
 - o Library and Internet: Use the local and school library. Practice safe searching!
 - Parents & Family: Your parents and family can be excellent sources of information for you.
 You should talk to them about your topic and get their ideas of where to go for information
 - <u>Faculty:</u> Teachers and Staff can also help you with information and direct you to other sources of information.
