- The Challenge begins on the first day of school and ends May 12, 2013.
- To count as completing this year's Reading Hall of Fame all books must be read and turned in by May 19, 2013.
- No more than 2 books can be read out loud to the student.
- Choose "Just Right" books to read.
- If you have a question about if the book will qualify ask your teacher or the school librarian.
- After you have read the book, a teacher or parent needs to initial next to each title read.
- When you have completed the challenge, turn your paper into Mrs. Adams in the Media Center.
- Except for the two read-a-loud books all other books must be read at home or in class during independent silent reading.
- Classroom assigned book club books are independent of the Reading Hall of Fame and do not count towards its completion.
