Fox Hollow Community Council Responsibilities

The Fox Hollow Community Council is a committee made up of parents and school professionals who help determine the needs of our school and the best methods and programs to support those needs through the School Trust lands Program. Members of the school community council will meet once a month in the conference room to discuss the school's needs, the School Trust land plan, and its implementation.

The Council Members are:

- An advisory group
- Ambassadors for the school
- Advocates for school programs and children

School Community Councils responsibilities are:

- 1. To review school SAGE data and other assessments,
- 2. To develop a School Improvement Plan.
- 3. To develop a School LAND Trust Plan.
- 4. To advise the school administration on local school issues,
- 5. To provide an opportunity for issues of concern in the community to be presented to the school administration.
- 6. To develop a reading achievement plan.

Parents who serve on the council are chosen by election for a two-year term. Nominations are due each year at our back to school night. The voting for council members takes place two weeks after the back to school night.
