Recess During the Winter

Fox Hollow follows guidelines per Alpine School District concerning weather related issues concerning recess. While getting outside to play and expend some energy during the day is important for students, safety in this is of great importance. When temperatures dip below 20°F, including windchill, students are kept inside. Wind, snow, rain and lightning may also require an inside day. We monitor temps and air quality thoughout each day and make the call to stay inside as necessary.

Some things to note:

- -When you see the red flag outside, it is an inside day until the weather or air quality changes.
- -Students are expected to go outside for recess when weather permits. Appropriate warm clothing, including hats and gloves will help your child be comfortable while outside for recess.
- -Children with respiratory sensitivities, who cannot be outside for recess, may stay inside with a parent's note or a phone call to the school.
