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Dear Parents of New Kindergarten Students:

For kindergarten attendance for the 2020/2021 school year, Utah State law requires the following immunizations for the protection of your child and others from communicable diseases:

5 DTaP 4 Polio 2 MMR 3 Hepatitis B 2 Hepatitis A

****2 Varicella (Chickenpox)**

The 5th DTP and 4th Polio immunizations need to be given after the child's 4th birthday, the first MMR and Chickenpox vaccines must be given after the first birthday.

******(Documentation of varicella disease or “chicken pox” must be confirmed by your licensed healthcare provider if no varicella immunizations have been given.)

To claim a **personal, religious or medical exemption**, the legal guardian must complete an on-line educational module (free of charge) and provide a copy of the completed form to the school official. The on-line course can be found at www.immunize-utah.org. *Completion of the on-line educational module can be done at the Health Department if you do not have access to a computer. For a **medical exemption**, a written note from a licensed health care provider must be provided along with a copy of the completed on-line educational module. It should state the physical condition of the student, and why that vaccine would endanger the student's life or health.*

Immunizations are available from your personal physician or from the Utah County Health Department (UCHD) at the following times and locations. If your child needs immunizations and you will be getting them at UCHD, please bring your records of previous immunizations when you come.

A physical examination, including vision screening, and a dental examination are strongly recommended for entering kindergarten students. UCHD Wellness Clinic performs physicals for \$30. Appointments can be made by calling 801-851-7031. Physical and dental exams and immunizations are advised in the spring or early summer to avoid crowds in the fall.

Para Padres de Nuevos Estudiantes de Kindergarten:

Para asistir al kindergarten para el año escolar 2020/2021, la ley del estado de Utah requiere las siguientes vacunas para la protección de su hijo y otras personas contra enfermedades contagiosas:

5 DTaP	4 Polio	2 MMR	3 Hepatitis B	2 Hepatitis A
**2 Varicela				
Las vacunas de DTP y 4th Polio deben administrarse después de que el niño cumpla los 4 años, las vacunas de MMR y Chickenpox se deben administrar después del primer cumpleaños.				

******(Si su hijo(a) ha tenido varicela, la enfermedad debe ser confirmada por su médico, especialmente si a su estudiante nunca se le han administrado vacunas contra la varicela.)

Para obtener una exención personal, religiosa o médica, el tutor legal debe completar, gratuitamente, un módulo educativo por el internet y proporcionar una copia del certificado que se obtiene al terminar el modulo a la escuela. El curso por el internet se puede encontrar en www.immunize-utah.org. Si no tiene acceso a una computadora, puede completar el módulo educativo en las oficinas del Departamento de Salud. Para una exención médica, se debe proporcionar una nota escrita por su médico, junto con una copia de que ha completado el módulo educativo en el internet. Debe indicar la condición física del estudiante y por qué esa vacuna pondría en peligro la vida o la salud del estudiante.

Las vacunas están disponibles con su médico personal o en el Departamento de Salud del Condado de Utah (UCHD) en los siguientes horarios y lugares. Si su hijo necesita vacunas y las recibirá en el UCHD, traiga sus registros de vacunas que haya recibido previamente cuando venga.

Un examen físico es altamente recomendado, también se recomienda un examen de la vista y un examen dental para ingresar a los estudiantes de kindergarten. Utah School Registration Immunization Requirements

Utah State Law requires that all students must submit a completed immunization record to the school **BEFORE THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL ATTENDANCE. THESE REQUIREMENTS ARE IN EFFECT FOR THE 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR IN ALL UTAH PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS.** A student must have proof of the following immunizations for school enrollment or submit one of the three exemptions listed below.

EXEMPTIONS

PERSONAL RELIGIOUS & MEDICAL

All **new** students, students entering **Kindergarten and 7th grade** the legal guardian must complete an on-line educational module (free of charge) and provide a copy of the completed form to the school official. The on-line course can be found at www.immunize-utah.org. *Completion of the on-line educational module can be done at the Health Department if you do not have access to a computer. For a **medical exemption**, a written note from a licensed health care provider must be provided along with a copy of the completed on-line educational module. It should state the physical condition of the student, and why that vaccine would endanger the student's life or health.*

Results of a completed **TB test (PPD)** given in the U.S. within 90 days or results of a chest x-ray taken within the last year must be presented before school attendance begins by all students who have moved in from a foreign country (except Canada) or who have been out of the country for 6 months or more. A TB test given within the last five years is also required for all entering kindergarten who were born in a foreign country (except Canada). If BCG (a TB immunization) was given within the last year, the student must wait one year from the date of the BCG to receive a PPD, but they may attend school during that time period until the PPD can be given.

A child may be allowed to attend school "conditionally" if at least one dose of each required immunization series has been completed and the child is currently on schedule to finish the rest. The remaining immunizations must be completed on schedule for the child to remain in attendance.
