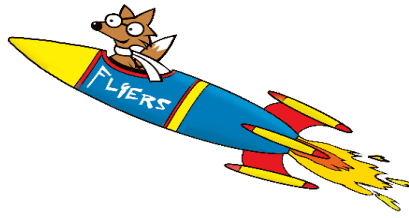

We hope the convenience of completing registration forms through our website in the comfort of your home and at your convenience makes the registration process a little easier.

Please note these two important dates:

Registration Form Available Online: February 24th, 8:00am

Parents may complete their child's registration online for the 2020-2021 school year as early as Monday, February 24th. Once the online form has been submitted official forms will be printed in the school office. Parents may come in as early as 10:00am the following day or anytime thereafter during office hours.

To bring with you when you come to sign paperwork:

- Sign official registration documents generated by online registration, printed by school
- Bring with you: Original Birth Certificate, immunizations(or exemption), proof of residency, custody documents(if applicable), picture id
- Complete Online Transportation Form

Registration will be complete once these steps have been taken by parent/guardian at the school before the time request date.

Time Request Opens Online: March 24th, 8:00am

Time request may only be made and considered after all registration forms have been signed and required documentation is turned in.

Online Kindergarten registration is new this year. We anticipate a smooth transition, but thank you for your patience in advance for any growing pains we may experience with this change.
