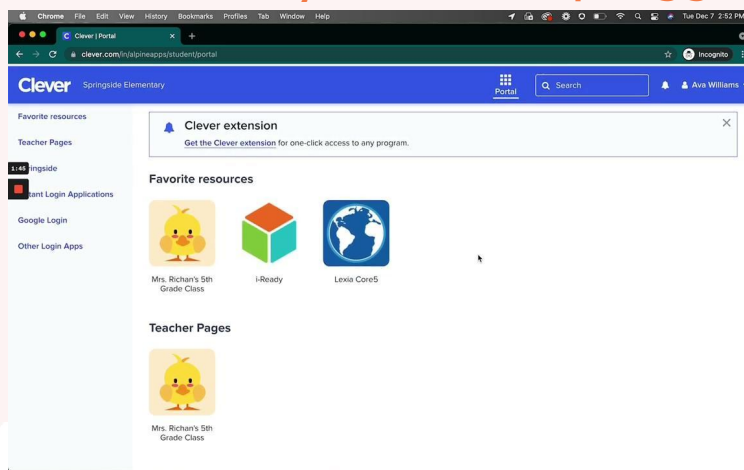

TIPS AND TRICKS FOR LOGGING IN

- *Chrome tends to work best for Clever, Lexia, and Ready
- *If you are using an iPad, you will need to make sure you have the Clever App downloaded. It is a good idea to download Clever, iReady, and Lexia.
- *You can ONLY log in to iReady through Clever, even with the app.

KINDERGARTEN

If students are unable to access online lessons, please use the choice board below. Please choose at least three of the assignments for language arts & three of the assignments for math to complete today.

ELA

Read 2 stories with a parent or brother/sister. Pick one of those stories and draw a picture of the setting and characters. Show your family member your picture and see if they can guess which book you chose to represent.

ELA

Choose your favorite blanket and picture books, and read them with a family member for 20 minutes. After, choose one of the books you read and retell the story by acting it out (what happened first, next, and last).

ELA

Go on an alphabet scavenger hunt around your house! Write each letter of the alphabet on a piece of a paper, and find an item that starts with each letter.

ELA

Log on and do 15 minutes of Lexia

ELA

- Think of an awesome story.
1. Draw a picture.
 2. Say your sentence(s) out loud.
 3. Count how many words are the sentence(s).
 4. Write your sentence(s).
 5. Share your story with a family member.

MATH

Point to a number on a 100 chart. Find the number that is 1 more, 1 less, 10 more, and 10 less.

MATH

Go around your house on a shape scavenger hunt. Look for: circles, squares, rectangles, triangles, hexagons, spheres, cylinders, cones, cubes, etc..

MATH

Log on to Clever and do 15 minutes of iReady

MATH

Grab 2 dice and a family member. Each person gets a dice and will compare numbers to see who has the highest. Next round compare to see who has the lowest.

MATH

Grab a handful of cereal, dry pasta, or small toys. Use those to create addition problems. How many ways can you create sums between 1 and 10?



FIRST GRADE

If students are unable to access online lessons, please use the choice board below. Please choose at least three of the assignments for language arts & three of the assignments for math to complete today.

ELA

Choose a story to read. After reading the story write down the main idea and 3 details.

ELA

Write an opinion paper about your favorite snow activity. Include two reasons why it is your favorite. Remember a closing sentence.

ELA

Silly Story

Write a story using all your spelling words and HFW

ELA

Find your list of high frequency words. Choose a way to practice this week's words. (Rainbow write, find in a book, write sentences, write in a salt tray, etc)

ELA

Read to a family member for 20 minutes. Write down their favorite part of the story. Do you agree with their favorite part? Include your answer.

ELA

Write a narrative about the activities that you are doing today. Remember to include an opening sentence, temporal words, details, and a closing sentence.

ELA

Grab a couple handfuls of cereal. Divide your cereal into groups of 10 and any leftover ones. How many 10s and how many ones? Write the number to tell how much you have.

ELA

Do 15 minutes of Lexia

MATH

Point to a number on a 120 chart. Find the number that is 1 more, 1 less, 10 more, and 10 less.

MATH

Skip count by 2's, 5's, and 10's to 120. Too easy? Start at 100 and count by 2's, 5's and 10's to 200.

MATH

Roll 2 die. Write a subtraction sentence and find the difference. Roll the die again and write an addition sentence and find the sum.

MATH

Grab a couple handfuls of cereal. Divide your cereal into groups of 10 and any leftover ones. How many 10s and how many ones? Write the number to tell how much you have.

MATH

Play a game where you need to add the dice or make some flashcards and practice your math facts.

MATH

Go around your house on a shape scavenger hunt. How many circles can you find? How many squares? How many triangles?

MATH

Log in to Clever and do 20 minutes of iReady

MATH

Practice finding the missing numbers by 1s, 10, and 5s.
For example:

14, 15, __, 17
25, 30, 35, __, 45
40, 50, __, 70



SECOND GRADE

If students are unable to access online lessons, please use the choice board below. Please choose at least three of the assignments for language arts & three of the assignments for math to complete today.

ELA

Write a friendly letter to a family member. Draw a picture to go with it. Make sure you include the date, greeting, body of the letter, closing and your name.

ELA

Choose 5 spelling words and write a sentence for each. Be sure to include a noun, verb and 2 adjectives in each sentence.

ELA

Read for at least 20 minutes. Get a piece of paper and write at least 5 sentences about the story. Tell about the setting, beginning of the story, the middle and how the story ended.

ELA

Finish this writing prompt:
*If I were a snowman,
I would...*

Make sure to include the topic sentence, sequence words for 3 details, and a conclusion sentence. Draw a picture for your writing.

ELA

Choose a book to read. After reading compare 2 characters in the story. Use a Venn Diagram to show how the characters are similar and different.

ELA

Make a fort somewhere in your house. Get some of your favorite books and a flashlight. Have fun reading by flashlight. If you want invite another family member to join you in reading in the fort.

Choose a recipe to bake! Follow the recipe using correct measurements, and estimate how many people will be able to eat the item.

Pick 4 fact families and write down the four equations that go with each family. You should have 16 equations in all.

Grab a deck of cards and play multiplication war with a family member

Read a short story to someone in your house and retell it from a character's point of view.

ELA

Build a snowman. Write a story about your adventures with your snowman.

ELA

Build a fort and read in your fort (maybe with a flashlight for 20 minutes) Write a short summary (retelling) of what you read

Write and illustrate a comic strip about a snowman that comes to life.

Pick a friend or family member and write a letter to them. Use your best writing.

MATH

Write 2 multiplication and division problems about snow. See if someone can solve them.

MATH

Practice your math facts for 10 minutes 3 different times during the day.

MATH

Build a snowman. Measure how tall each part and the total height. Write a story problem about your snowman.

MATH

Make cookies and double the recipe. How many cookies does everyone in your family get?

MATH

Play a board game. Before each turn, answer a math fact problem.

MATH

Build a snow fort. Find the area and perimeter of your snow fort in feet or inches.

MATH

Make your own math board game with math problems to solve for each turn.

Do iReady math lessons for 30 minutes

ELA

What was the last movie you watched? Type up a review of your thoughts on the movie and tell whether you would recommend it to others.

ELA

Read in a fort or other space you design for 30 minutes. Write 2 questions before reading, 2 during reading, and 2 questions after reading.

ELA

Write at least 10 questions and interview a family member, record it, and show your family.

Make a snowman, play in the snow or go sledding. Write a "How-to" story telling me how to do what you chose to do in the snow.

Help your family create a shopping list. Estimate how much each item will cost and estimate the total. When it is safe to go to the store, compare your estimate to the receipt.

MATH

With a ruler, measure how deep the snow is outside. Online, look up how many inches it has snowed today in other parts of the world and graph the results.

Play games with your family members and track who wins each round. Then create a graph of wins and losses.

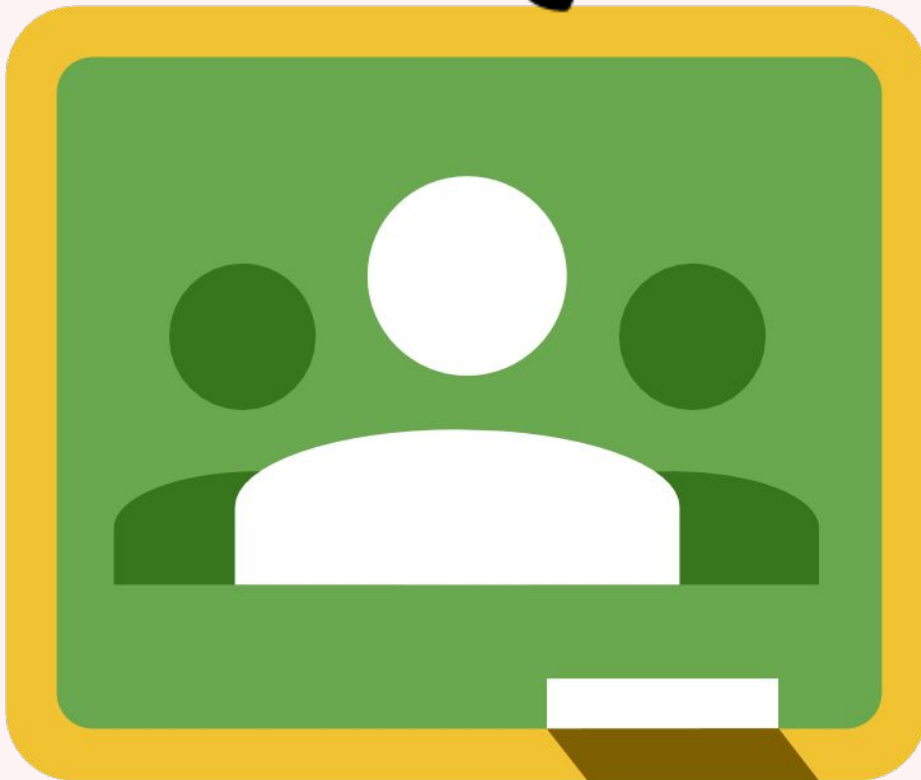
