Principal's Corner

As we welcome the month of October at Greenwood Elementary, we're excited and confident about the things happening at our school. Here are some of the reasons that we invite you to share in our excitement:

- We are introducing and continuing a variety of extra-curricular opportunities at our school this year. Students have the chance to participate in the American Fork Children's Choir, a Robotics Club, a Coding Class, or a Girl Scout Troop.
- The percentage of students attending school every day is 94%.
- Students are showing improvement in their proficiency on the year-end SAGE testing. Our scores school-wide are as follows:
 - 43% proficiency in Language Arts (an increase of 3% from last year)
 - 53% proficiency in Mathematics (an increase of 11% from last year)
 - 49% proficiency in Science (a decrease of 4% from last year)
 - Though our science scores experienced a slight decrease from last year, they are still above the state average.
- Our Facebook page and website provide a peek into some of the other incredible learning experiences that our students are having at school each day.

As you can see, amazing things are happening at our school. Thank you for all that you do to support the learners at Greenwood. I love being a Gator, and I love working with your students.
