Join us this summer for Bright Ideas as we **PUZZLE IT OUT!**

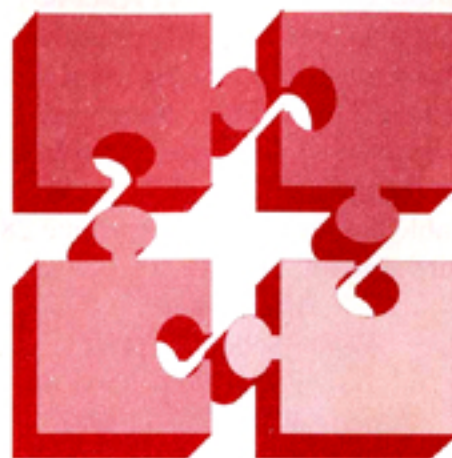
