The purpose of Head Start is to improve school readiness and promote long-term success for children and families. We want to prepare children to enter kindergarten ready to learn. In our classrooms, children are provided with age-appropriate, meaningful activities that focus on specific learning objectives. We also seek to promote family engagement through volunteer and leadership opportunities because family engagement in children's learning is crucial to achieving positive educational outcomes for children.

We are a diverse program serving at least 10% of children with disabilities, different ethnic communities, and have a bi-lingual staff that speak English and Spanish at 10 sites. Check our website to find the site nearest you.

Transportation is available on a limited basis at a few of our sites. Where transportation is not available, parents are asked to provide transportation and may be assisted by participating in Mountainland Head Start's carpooling program.

Documents required for enrollment application:

Child's birth record (birth certificate, official hospital birth record, blessing certificate or passport). Child must be 3 or 4 years old by Sept 1 of application year.

 Proof of family's gross income. W-2, 1040 or other tax record, pay stubs for one month, child support, SSA/ SSD, scholarships, grants, or other income documentation for each parent/guardian living in the home. Or, Foster/shelter placement letter from DCFS, or proof of SSI for any family member, or proof of TANF/FEP financial assistance.

 Child's up-to-date immunization record.
