### Did You Know?

\* Hidden Hollow earned a "B" grade as part of the state's UCAS report following spring 2014 SAGE testing. This is our first year administering the SAGE test, and this data will be helpful in setting future academic goals.

\* Hidden Hollow is in its seventh year.

\* We are a partnership school with the Utah Valley University School of Education. Two UVU interns are currently teaching at Hidden Hollow.

\* With the construction of Black Ridge Elementary, our enrollment has decreased from 1,350 last year to 850.

\* Hidden Hollow employs 37 teachers (32 women and 5 men) and an additional 23 staff members.

\* We host 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade Accelerated Learning Lab (A.L.L.) classes for gifted students, and will add a 4<sup>th</sup> grade A.L.L. class next year.

\* The Hidden Hollow Running Club continues this year with tremendous volunteers and student participation.

\* The Road to Success Reading Incentive Program is in its second year with a goal that students will read over 2 million minutes!

\* We are beginning our first Robotics program in January 2015.

\* This is our first year hosting a tuition-paying preschool. Both a.m. and p.m. sessions are available.

## School Trust Lands

The School Trust Lands Administration has the responsibility to generate funds for Utah's public schools from public lands that are held in trust by the state. Hidden Hollow received over \$65,000 for 2013-2014. After gathering input from patrons and teachers, the School Community Council determined how to best use these funds to support academic needs at Hidden Hollow.

### ***With those funds and as part of the School Improvement Plan:***

1. Teachers collaborated regularly, including during the summer, to revise lesson plans, develop common assessments, and update scope and sequence.
2. Teachers who did not have an iPad and requested one were given one for individual use and classroom instruction. Additional chromebooks and charging/storage carts were purchased.
3. Grades 1-4 implemented a double dosing program during the year. Each grade, based on individual need, organized their program to improve attendance and participation.
4. Trueflix, RAZKIDS, Reading A to Z, and TimezAttack licenses were renewed. Some additional apps were purchased. A one-hour per day aide was retained to manage the Take-Home Reading Library.
5. Approximately \$6,200 was spent on guided reading and character education books.

### ***Measuring progress towards academic goals:***

In addition to end-of-year SAGE scores, DRA data will be used to determine current reading levels at the beginning of the year and students who are reading below grade level. Our goal is for each student to show improvement between the fall and winter DRA, specifically to move two students per class from below benchmark to benchmark or above. We also seek to improve by two students per grade those at the mastery level in language arts, science and math.

\*\* The School Community Council reviews the school Trust Land Plan annually.
