Hallway and Restroom Rules

Lunchroom Rules

- 1. Walk slowly.
- 2. Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself.
- 3. Talk quietly, and only to people at your table.
- 4. Use food and utensils properly.
- 5. Never take food from others without their permission.
- 6. Don't take food or drinks out of the lunchroom.
- 7. Keep your area clean and throw away trash.
- 8. Exit through the North doors and go directly upstairs and outside.

Consequences may include: 1. Verbal warning 2. Move to back of line 3. Help wash tables/mop up spills 4. Loss of lunch recess 5. Discipline Assignment is given

Assembly Rules

1. Be courteous and show respect for performers, audience, and equipment. Consequences may include: 1. Verbal warning 2. Move student close to teacher or by wall 3. Discipline Assignment is given 4. Phone call home 5. Student misses next assembly

Additional Playground Rules

DO NOT:

jump off playground equipment

jump out of swings

twist up the swings

swing sideways

play any type of tackle game

climb on basketball rims, trees, swing sets, backstops, soccer goals, fences, etc.

throw snow or other objects, besides playground balls, that can injure someone

swear or call names

misuse playground equipment

bring racquetballs, baseballs, softballs, from home (tennis balls are acceptable)

"lock out" games

play near district mowers, trucks, or other equipment

go into the Red Zone

kick playground balls while on the blacktop

DO:

include everyone in your games

be friendly and kind to all

think twice - if it is not right don't do it

Go home when you're supposed to. After 4:00 p.m., and with parent permission, you may return to the playground.

Additional School Rules

Carry basketballs, etc. in the halls rather than dribbling them.

Only students with hall passes or a teacher escort will be allowed in classroom hallways during lunch and before school.

Students should go outside at recess and lunchtime unless they have a parent note requesting that they stay inside.

Faculty Room and Teacher Work Rooms are designated "Teacher Only" areas.

No student should leave the school grounds during school hours unless accompanied by his/her teacher, checked out by a parent or other responsible adult, or going home for lunch (requires prior permission).

Bicycles brought to school should be locked in the bike racks and must not be ridden at school during school hours. Skateboards and roller blades may be ridden to school if they can be stored in the student's classroom cubby. They should also not be ridden during school hours.

Do not bring toys of any kind to school (including radios, CD and MP3 players, pocket knives, squirt guns, dolls, trading cards, etc.) Such items will be taken and returned only to the parent. Cell phones are allowed if they are turned off during school hours.

Students are allowed to use the school phone only for illness and other emergencies.

Follow the Alpine School District Dress Code:

- 1. All children should dress modestly, and appropriate to the weather
- 2. No short shorts. Shorts that are near the knee are O.K.
- 3. "Grubby" clothing or clothing containing vulgarities, profanities, obscenities, or advertisements for alcohol, tobacco, or drugs are never acceptable. Clothing which is ragged, tattered, or deliberately distracting in appearance must be avoided.
- 4. Hats or other headgear should not be worn indoors, except during special programs or activities.
- 5. Tank tops or bare midriff shirts or blouses are unacceptable.
- 6. Hair should be clean and well groomed. Hairstyles that are distracting in appearance are not acceptable.
- 7. Students must wear appropriate footwear. Flip Flops are not allowed.
