- STEM Conference - Steve Spangler Science
 - July 2019 - 3 days
 - \$1095/person (early), \$1295/person
 - Get \$400 worth of equipment
 - Teachers would come back and offer Professional Development here
 - Hidden Hollow is a STEM School - Connected Learning School
 - Need Cabinet approval - will take some time
 - Could help with PTA STEAM Night
- Dibles Results - Missy Checketts
 - 1st grade Goal: Phonemic sounds - 80% proficiency
 - 37% of students have reached that goal so far this year!
 - 1st grade Goal: 47 phonemic sounds by end of year
 - 99% of students have reached that goal!
 - 1st grade Goal: 75% of first grade reading 25 words (17 middle of the year)
 - 38% right now
 - 1st grade Goal: Fluency - Read 34 words/minute
 - 39% of first graders are there or higher
 - Mr. Davies:
 - Aides are doing a great job!
 - Tier 1 needs to be done everyday!
 - We've made incredible growth in a year and half!
- Parking Lot Update (\$120,000 from the district to make this possible)
 - Eliminates 2 street crossings!
 - 50% time reduction to get out of parking lot
 - Research:
 - School leaders visited other schools to come up with a plan
 - New Plan:
 - See email
 - No loading/unloading in red zone or purple zone
 - Will post signs

- 8 Rules:
 - Enter only on right side of vehicle
 - Left lane is drive-thru only
 - Load and unload kids in marked zones
 - Pull forward to orange cones
 - No parking/unattended vehicles during drop off and pick up times
 - Bus Zone
 - Walk children to/from car if not in load/unload zone
 - Students who are waiting over 10 minutes will go to the vestibule area next to the office

- Budget
 - \$1287 can be moved around
 - UCET - March 5 and 6 (5 teachers)
 - \$60/person, \$200/sub = \$1300
 - IMSE - March 11-15 (5 teachers)
 - \$1175, + \$500/sub = \$8,375
 - Instructional Leadership in 21st Century (2 teachers)
 - \$359/teacher \$200/sub = \$1118
