1. ASD Bond Meeting-

- a. Discussed bond nature and monies are paid up until 2012. ASD is AAA Bonded with excellent credit. ASD will apply for new bond in 2020 to fund district wide growth explosion and older building renovations.
 - i. Growth predictions are expected to be 87,000 students in 2024
- b. New projects
 - i. Cedar Valley High School
 - ii. Lake Mountain Middle School
 - iii. New unnamed elementary in Eagle Mountain will open in August for next school year. School is located in the Silverlake area of Eagle Mountain by Brookside Elementary.
 - iv. New middle school in Lehi
 - v. New elementary in Eagle Mountain built by Black Ridge Elementary
 - vi. New elementary in Vineyard
- c. Rebuilds and renovations
 - i. Many older buildings are being repaired and rebuilt to meet earthquake preparedness standards.
 - ii. Cascade Elementary will house district planetarium.
 - 1. Mostly funded through private donations
 - 2. Partnered with Clark Planetarium
- d. Security increases
 - i. Older elementary buildings with offices in the back of the school were remodeled to have front offices.
 - ii. Keyless entries installed in all schools.
 - iii. Camera systems being outfitted in all high schools.
- e. Future options to address growth explosion
 - i. 2020 bond
 - ii. Year round school: 6 weeks in session. 3 weeks off
 - iii. Double sessions: AM/PM schedules
 - iv. Blended/remote learning options
 - v. Boundary adjustments
 - vi. Portable classrooms/satellite
 - vii. School grade level configuration
- 2. John Truesdell will review RISE data for upper grades
 - a. RISE will be support by new company this year.

- b. Overall proficiency is generally healthy but 42% of HHES students are below or approaching benchmark proficiency.
- c. How do we engage ALL learners? What can we do to help improve every student?
 - i. Students should progress each year. For example, a student may start the school year as approaching proficiency. The goal would be to have the student start the following school year as proficient.
