MATURATION PROGRAM

The Board of Education authorizes the District Administration to conduct instruction on:

- Community and personal health
- Personal hygiene
- Family life
- Prevention of communicable disease
- Refusal skills
- and, the harmful effects of pornography

(USBE Administrative Rule R277-474 and Utah Code 53G-10-402)

In order for the student to attend or receive MATURATION instruction, there is a consent form the parents must sign and return to the school prior to the presentation. The consent form is available in Skyward (Parent Access) under the Student Information Update. A written permission form is also available through the school.
