Message from Mr. Hodson

Kindergarten registration at Highland Elementary School opens Monday, March 28th. You may register your child from 8:00 AM to 3:30 PM. You may pick up registration materials before March 28, 2016. However, they will not be accepted until the first day of kindergarten registration.

It is important to have all new

kindergarten students registered as close to this time as possible. The number of kindergarten teachers on staff reflects on how many students have signed up for the 2016-17 school year.

Children must be 5 years old on or before September 2, 2016, to be qualified to register for public school next year. When you come to register your kindergarten student please bring an official birth certificate, immunization records, Social Security number (optional), and if possible, a check for \$10 made out to Highland Elementary School for kindergarten class activities. Please share this information with others that have children of kindergarten age.

Traffic safety is important at Highland Elementary. We want all of our children to be safe as they travel to and from school. Our parking lots are very crowded as the school day opens and closes. We request the help of every person entering the Highland parking lots. Courteous, careful and slow driving cannot be emphasized enough. Please allow enough time to remain calm and safe as you bring students to school. DRIVERS SHOULD NOT DRIVE FASTER THAN 3 M.P.H. in the parking area. If a child forgets a basic rule of safety, it is up to the drivers to be alert and drive safely and slowly enough to stop their vehicles in time to prevent a serious accident.

Please remember our TRAFFIC SAFETY RULES:

- 1) Observe and use the proper entrances and exits from the parking areas.
- 2) When loading or unloading your children always pull your vehicle next to the curb or the right edge of the loading/unloading lane and have your student(s) exit or enter from the passenger side of the car. Never stop in the middle of the drive through lane to enter or exit children from your vehicle and never pass a vehicle on the right.

Click-It!

Utah's Click-it Program is in full force here at Highland Elementary. Currently, we are encouraging booster seat use. Why?? I think we can all relate to the reluctant child or parent who just doesn't want to use them! Did you know your child qualifies for a booster seat by height NOT age?! A person advances from a booster when they are taller than 4'9". That's

right! For some, this fact is bad news.

The purpose of the booster seat is to prevent serious internal injuries caused by the improper position of the seat belt. Children under 4'9", who use a seat belt only, are four times more likely to sustain serious injuries than a child using a booster seat (Zerofatalities.com) Children in side-impact crashes benefited most when booster seats were used: risk of injury was reduced 68 percent for near-side impacts, and 82% for far-side impacts (CBSNews By David Morgan)

We love your students and want them to enjoy long years of health. May our cause be a support to your family and help prevent harm to these wonderful children.
