# A Word from Mr. Gibb

Dear Parents,

Your child's safety at school is important. It is also important for them to arrive and return home safely. I'm sure you've noticed the tangle of bikes locked to the fence and bike racks at Legacy. I am pleased that so many students walk and bike to school. I am also concerned about students cycling habits to and from school. The Legacy PTA and School Community Council share this concern.

I ask for you help giving specific instruction to your students about bicycle and pedestrian safety. Just recently, one of Legacy's students had a minor collision with a vehicle on the way home from school. The student was uninjured, and all ended well. However, the accident underscored the need to be vigilant about safety with all students. I believe this begins with instructions from parents. You are vital to insisting on safe habits.

Please take time today to specifically review and practice these safety rules with your child:

Mark your calendar for October 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup>.


We hope having these activities will help give your family a night to just slow down and hang out together!



#### Continued~Bike Safety

- Children should travel a safe, predetermined route to school. You can find a map of the safe routes to Legacy at:
- http://www.snapforschool s.com/Map\_view.aspx?Ent ityID=1345
- ALWAYS use crosswalks. Students on bicycles should get off their bicycles and walk across the street.
- Students on bicycles SHARE the sidewalk with pedestrians. Students on bicycles should always use sidewalks, especially on 1340 North, 150 West and 6000 West. We have students who daily dart into roads between vehicles, without any attention to traffic. This means students on bikes will need to slow down and wait for students who are walking.
- Pedestrians and cyclist should never assume drivers are paying attention. Teach your student to make EYE CONTACT with drivers at intersections. It is important they know they have been seen.
- Always wear a bicycle helmet.

Finally, I plead with drivers to be careful with your driving habits near the school. The majority of traffic is patrons who are busily trying to be many places at once.



Please obey traffic rules, look carefully for students at all times, and SLOW down. Plan for extra time to avoid rushing. I appreciate your consistent help teaching your child these safety rules.
