I love the PTA, I really do. It's a chance for me as a parent to work with the teachers to see that our children are taken care. It's a chance to be involved and to have a voice.


We have had a great year with the PTA. We have tried our best to make everything we do be about the kids, that's how it's *suppose* to be.
