

Community Council Meeting
Legacy Elementary
October 22, 2013

Present at this meeting: Bethany Cathemer, Tami Galbraith, Charlotte Hutchinson, Kim Conant, Gary Gibb, Zack Starr. Aaron Raymond was absent.

A motion was made to approve the minutes from last meeting. Kim made the motion and Charlotte seconded.

A motion was made to approve the meeting schedule for this year. Tami motioned and Kim seconded.

The Council discussed the rules and order of procedure and the basic template that was presented at the State training held 10/15/2013--these rules are a part of the council bylaws in large measure already.

A discussion was held about some of the items presented at the 10/15 State training including RIMS and data interpretation.

Gary presented the Alpine School District mission, vision, values, and goals pamphlet and how it is implemented at Legacy.

Gary presented the data review information for booster club. The Council discussed how to ensure children involved are maximizing attendance and understanding barriers to attendance for the children involved. Gary suggested he take the ideas to the booster club liaisons and teachers. Kim will write down some ideas and thoughts about a parent survey in order to obtain feedback.

Gary presented information on the school district collaboration incentive. Kim reported on her experience last year in participating/observation. The parents discussed a schedule for visiting the collaboration sessions. Kim will coordinate the scheduling and submit by email. First parent visits will take place on November 18.
