Minutes from the last meeting were approved. Motion by Krista Wells, second by Zach Starr. No discussion. Unanimous vote.

Data Review

Mr. Gibb presented an overview of Trustlands Funds and Budget. He gave an explanation of the Budget, Balance and what is remaining. There was a review of the history of funding that has been received.

Booster Club Survey

A Survey was sent to all patrons. Survey results were shared with CC members. The survey provided good information to evaluate Booster Club. The majority of communication is coming from teachers in informing parents of the program. Survey indicated that communication is a weak area and can be improved. CC felt that communication was already improving and should continue. The survey showed that Booster Club is valued by parents and they want this program to continue for students. The intervention it provides is important. Comments from the survey gave specific feedback about the impact of the program on students.

Writing Assessment

87% of our students are passing Benchmark. Students are becoming better writers as they progress through grade levels. SAGE testing next year will include the option of testing throughout the year rather than just in spring. Mr. Gibb will be learning more about SAGE testing-how it will be implemented. This will show a measurement of progress made.

School Improvement and Trustlands 2014-15

School Trustlands Grant proposal is due April 4. The CC is working to have grant ready for discussion and possible approval by March 18 meeting. Final approval will be after the Parent meeting on March 27, 2014. Mr. Gibb will send draft proposal electronically to Council members.
