*Welcome and introductions of the new members.

The purpose of the council was reviewed. The council members were asked to go to the website www.schoollandtrust.org for training and information on Council responsibilities. Council members were assigned to view the training videos "Touch the Future" and "Earning for Education," both available at schoollandtrust.org.

*Selection of Chair and Co-Chair .

Bethany was nominated by Lucy-second by Tami and closed by Gary. After discussion voting was unanimous-Bethany Cathemer will be the Chair.
Zach Starr was nominated by Bethany-second by Angie and Lucy closed by Bethany. After discussion, voting was unanimous-Zach will be the Co-Chair.

*Calendar

The Calendar of scheduled meeting will be posted for patrons so they can attend. Council members will also be invited to attend some collaborative meetings with teachers in conjunction with the ASD Collaborative Incentive. There will be training by ASD and also state training available for council members. Dates and locations for these are at schoollandtrust.org. There was some discussion about meeting times. A preliminary schedule of meetings will be sent to Council members for approval, then posted to the school website.

The next meeting will be September 25 at 4 p.m.

*Review of School Land Trust Plan.

Gary gave an explanation of School Land Trust. All funds from last year's grant were spent, with an overage of \$2092. After benefits are determined, the overage will be closer to \$1200. This overage will be covered with other school budgets.

This year's funds will be used for Booster Club, Summer Collaborative Grants, Teacher Aides, as described in the grant proposal.

Mindy Davis gave a presentation on MasteryConnect, an online tool used by teachers to map curriculum, track student progress, and manage assessments. This tool is already in use by teachers. A proposal was made to amend the Trustlands Grant to fund MasteryConnect school wide. The cost of the program for a one-year subscription is \$4,139.. Motion to amend was made by Tami, second by Lucy. Discussion: MasteryConnect fits with the goals of the grant as written. \$12,192 was originally budgeted for Summer Collaboration Grants. Alpine School District funded 6/7 grants, thus reducing the

schools anticipated share. Grants for 5 teachers will cost \$5900. The vote was unanimous to amend the grant, and reallocate funds for the purchase of MasteryConnect.

*Safe Routes to school was discussed. There is a change in bus schedule this year. Legacy will have a 9:15 bus only. There is a need to evaluate our plan with changes. The next meeting will address Safe Routes. Council members were asked to get feedback from neighbors.

*Patron survey was discussed. SCC is interested in engaging parents and views the survey as a tool to help with this. Council will send ideas for questions and areas of interest for the survey to Bethany for discussion at the next meeting.
