Business Items:

Discussion items:

- Gary Gibb reported on School Trustlands Report. 2014-15 grant was implemented as described in the grant. It is due October 20. He will input all required items in that report.
- Parents and teachers can access information about SAGE requirements by going to sageportal.org. Teachers look at rubrics to align curriculum.
- Gary Gibb discussed allocated funds for last year, how they were spent and how they will be spent this year.
- Stakeholder Report is due November 6. Mr. Gibb would like to do a 20th Anniversary report celebrating Legacy's 20th year. It will highlight achievement and students. He would like input from council members on items to include. He is looking for someone with graphic skills to help with it.
- Data Review: 93% of students passed the spring 2015 writing assessments. This is improvement from 35% who passed for fall 2014 assessment. These assessments help teachers to know what needs to be done through the year.
- Legacy's 6th grade team reported on summer collaboration grant. David Geels, Cindi Dietz, Sara Workman and Dirk Crenshaw are the 6th grade team. They showed the curriculum map they developed, lesson plans, assesments, and mastery connect.
