Watched a video explaining the trust lands and discussed that the Alpine School District has determined that the school improvement plan and the Land trust plan can be 1 combined plan instead of 2 separate plans.

Review of Stakeholder Report

Went over the report and discussed possibilities for the funds for the current school year. All parent members are encouraged to come to a Monday collaboration meeting (2:45-3:45pm) and find out the needs and wants of the teachers. It would be good to contact the team leaders before attending the meeting so they are prepared if they wanted to make a presentation. It was decided that the parent members will go in Jan sometime.

One of the ideas of how to best use the Trust Lands money for this year is to purchase 2 chrome book carts for the lower level grades. That would cost approx. \$25,000 for two carts. Finding a grant to help supplement the cost of the carts would be ideal. Principle Tillman will forward some grant information to the parent members to see if there is a possibility to supplement the cost.

It was discussed that Mastery Connect is costing \$1163 for the annual renewal. Lucie would like to investigate options for Mastery connect and can contact Mrs. Flake who is the district liaison for the program.

Internet safety is currently being taught by the computer teachers and there is no need for an internet safety assembly since it is being covered. There is a USET conference in March that Mrs. Chase is attending that will cover more internet safety techniques. Principle Tillman will talk to the computer teachers to see if one of them could go as well. Possibility of having the teachers trade off and go every other year to ensure that they are up to date on internet safety practices.
