MAKING MATH EASIER

Mastering mathematics is absolutely essential for future opportunities in school and careers. Your child will need to reach a certain level of competency in math to take many advanced high school courses, to be admitted to college, and to have a wide variety of career choices. Here's how you can help them maximize their math smarts.







Help your child master the basic facts. Mastery of a basic fact means that children can give an answer in less than three seconds. Use flash cards to help your children learn basic facts. When they don't know and answer, have them lay out objects to solve the problem.

Help your child learn the vocabulary of mathematics. Check that your child can define new terms. Have them use models and simple problems to show you they understand how the term is used.

Help your child see that the mathematics he is learning is very much a part of everyday life. From statistics in sports to the sale price of clothing to the amount of gas needed to travel from one city to another, mathematics is important to us every day. Help your child to link his "school" math to practical events.

Show your child that you like mathematics. Letting your child see that you use math—and that you aren't afraid of it—will go much further to building positive attitudes than just telling them that they should learn it.

Help your child write their numbers neatly. Twenty-five percent of all errors in solving math problems can be traced back to sloppy number writing. Improve your child's number writing skills through practice.


You will need to bring your child's birth certificate and current immunization records. If new to the area, a proof of residency and any legal custody paperwork is also required.
