The PTA Reflections Program is designed to enhance Lehi Elementary's arts education program by providing an opportunity for students to explore their artistic talents and receive positive recognition for their efforts. The program has six arts areas—dance choreography, film production, literature, musical composition, photography, and visual arts. In Utah, we have the extra category of 3D-Art, which includes three-dimensional art in any other medium.

We encourage your students to enter because they learn how to look at things, people, and experiences in a fresh and exciting way; and become more interested in the ideas and works of others. Students in any grade can enter, and will be judged only against other students in their same grade. Judging is blind. Trophies are awarded for excellence, merit, and honorable mention for each grade.

Here's the info you need to help them enter:

Who: Any student in grades K through 6

Theme: "The World Would be a Better Place If..."

Deadline: November 3rd, 2014 (no exceptions)

Where to turn in entries:

before Nov. 3rd: in the front office

on November 3rd, before school: in the gym, or during the day in the front office.

How:

- 1. Come up with an original idea about how the world could be a better place.
- 2. Express it in one of the above categories.
- 3. Go to http://www.utahpta.org/reflections. Read the 2014 General & Arts Category Rules then print out and complete:
 - 2014 Student Entry Form Required for all categories
 - 2014 Artist Statement Forms Required (separate form for each category)
 - 2014 Consent Form Needed if recognizable voices or faces of anyone else other than the student are used in entries.

All entries must be students original work and submitted by only one student. Each entry must have a signed entry form and the appropriate artist statement form for their category. The artist statement is worth one half of the judging score.
