What is Meadow All About...


Meadow Elementary is dedicated to student learning. The Step-Up intervention plan provides an opportunity for ALL 730 students to learn the individual skills they need to succeed. Teachers collaborate each Monday, using data, to make sure students progress on their individual goals. As many districts have come to observe this model, these principals and teachers have returned to their respective schools and implemented similar programs there. Our philosophy is that all of us take responsibility for every child's learning. Not just the children in an individual's classroom. The innovations at Meadow make it an exceptional place to learn and grow.

Results of Reading Goal from our School Improvement Plan...

Our reading improvement plan was to decrease the percentage of students reading below benchmark by 10%, between January 2014 and May 2015. We exceeded our goal by 2%, resulting in a 12% (88 students) decrease of students below reading benchmark school-wide. We are very proud of our students who worked hard to meet and surpass our goal!

Land Trust Monies

Land Trust funds are given to Meadow every year. This year we were given a total of \$47,559 including a carry over from the previous year. The carry over was used to send 5 teachers to the Ron Clark Academy to see first hand increased student engagement. Land Trust monies support our Step-Up program, as well as teacher professional development and technology.
