SAFETY AND BUS CONDUCT

Students should be safe coming to school, while at school, and returning from school.

To and From School - Students Should:

- Know the route you want them to take.
- Obey traffic laws at all times.
- Be extra careful around cars and buses (especially in bad weather).

Riding the Bus - Students should take care of:

- Their bodies (back to back, seat to seat, feet down, etc.)
- Their voices (no yelling, screaming, arguing etc.)
- Anything they bring to school on the bus

Students are expected to exercise good behavior while waiting for and riding the school bus. They must realize that riding the bus is a privilege, not a right. This privilege can be revoked for good cause. Although the school is not directly involved in the transportation of students, we have great concern that students arrive at school and return home safely. Students who ride Bicycles, Skateboards and Scooters:

- Obey the same traffic rules as cars obey.
- Park bikes in the bike rack on the east side of the school and lock them.
- Not ride bikes, etc. during school hours and before school begins on school property.

Cars and Buses - Buses and cars should load and unload in front of the school in designated areas only.
