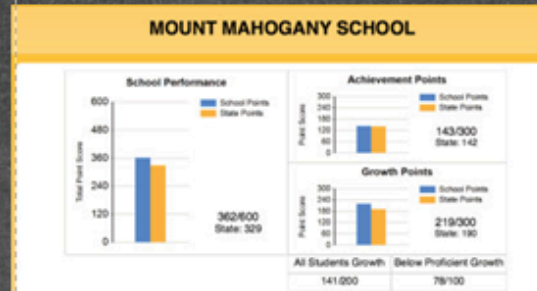

# Report of Goals

## Goal 1: SAGE/DRA

Increase DRA proficiency levels by 7 - 10% for students in grades first through third from fall 2014 to spring 2015 and 10% for students in grades fourth through sixth from fall 2014 to winter 2015. Also, without any baseline SAGE data, we want to at least see growth from fall SAGE interim to spring SAGE summative for students in grades third through sixth in reading and language arts.

The reading goal was to increase the percentages of students proficient on end of the year assessments. The two assessments that were given were the DRA and the SAGE test. With in the 2014-2015 school year the school proficiency with the SAGE test went from 40% proficient to 39% proficient. Third grade SAGE went from 58% to 41%. Fourth grade SAGE went from 27% proficient to 39% proficient. Fifth grade SAGE went from 41% proficient to 38%. Sixth grade SAGE went from 41% to 39%.

DRA scores in kindergarten went from winter 82% benchmark to 62% benchmark spring. First grade DRA scores were 46% benchmark fall, 72% benchmark winter, and 75% benchmark spring. Second grade scores were 54% benchmark fall, 74% benchmark winter, and 75% benchmark spring. Third grade DRA scores were 46% benchmark fall, 53% proficient winter, and 61% proficient spring. Fourth grade DRA benchmark were 47% fall and 60% benchmark winter. Fifth grade DRA scores were 40% benchmark fall and 53% benchmark winter. Sixth grade was 39% benchmark in fall and 72% benchmark in winter.

## Goal 2: Technology

Teachers were offered to come to school the day before their first contract day to attend an additional professional development about technology. Teachers were given instruction on Mastery Connect and different apps that could be used in the classroom to meet all levels of learners. The class was taught by two teachers at the school. Teachers were paid a stipend for teaching the class. Those in attendance were also given a stipend.

## Goal 3: Professional Development

Four teachers were given the opportunity to attend the CTES conference to assist them with reading and language arts instruction. Teachers were also given half-day subs to assist with other professional development activities.
