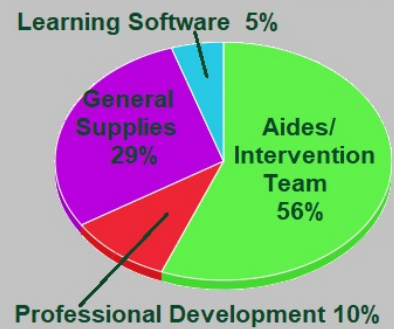


# SCHOOL COMMUNITY COUNCIL AND TRUSTLAND FUNDS

## 2019-2020 Trustland & Title I Goals

Our School-wide goal for the year will be to increase K-6 proficiency in language arts by 4% as measured by DIBELS. In addition, for students in grades 4-6, students will increase their proficiency by 4% as measured by the RISE Language Arts assessment. Our long-term goal is that 90% of 3rd Grade students will be reading on benchmark according to the DIBELS End of Year assessment. Teachers will receive training, be held accountable, celebrate, receive frequent feedback, and collect data to review in professional development meetings and weekly grade level collaboration.
