What is it? This is an opportunity for you to help raise money for North Point PTA Programs and take advantage of our great local

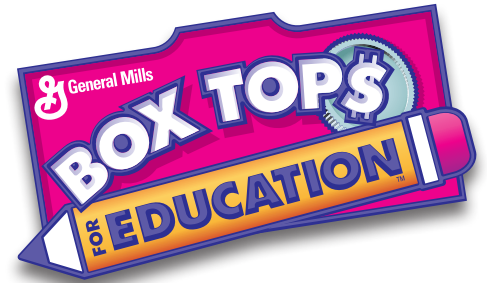
business, that you already go to anyway.
