**<u>Reading and approval of Minutes:</u>** Teri read the minutes from the February meeting, Aubrey approved the minutes, Leslie  $2^{nd}$  them.

**<u>School Improvement Plan (SIP)</u>**: The plan that was approved by the SCC for the year 2013-2114 is as follows:

Star Reading Coordinator – part time \$5,300 – (\$300 for supplies) Math tips coordinator - \$6,000 Double Dosing aide - \$6,000 (district will match) Copies and printing - \$1,000 Student Response System - \$5,000 (one set for lower grades and one set for upper grades) Brain Pop Jr. - \$1,200 for one year subscription for lower grades Brad Wilcox writing conference/day for teachers - \$4,500 – this amount will also cover manuals for teachers to have on hand for improving their teaching in the writing area. Equipment expenses - \$1,000 Science class assistance - \$2,000

TOTAL: \$32,000

\*\*\*In an email following the meeting, it was brought to the SCC's attention that the district would no longer pay for a subscription for a multiplication program called <u>Timez Attack</u>, because the price had gone up and they would no longer fund it. Mr. Bristow, a computer specialist at Northridge along with several parents on the committee, commented on the value of this program and would hate to see it go away. As a committee we decided to add this yearly subscription, in the amount of \$1,500 onto the plan that was decided on at our meeting. We anticipate receiving more funding next year, so at this time we will just add it onto our plan. If we don't receive more funding, then we will rearrange our money totals to make it work. With this subscription added on, the <u>TOTAL will be \$33,500</u>.
