The meeting was called to order by President Amber Blackett at 1:07 pm. She led us in the pledge and welcomed all in attendance. Introductions of the 2023-2024 PTA Board were given.

Esther read aloud the book *The Smallest Spot of a Dot*. The message is that our DNA is all mostly identical, but the small differences we share when we all come together makes us great as a team.

Esther Gwynn motioned that, "the April 2023 minutes be passed as presented." Naomi Wagstaff seconded the motion. The minutes will be sent out in this format via email prior to the meeting. We no longer have to read them aloud in the meeting as long as they've been sent out to all members who have paid dues ahead of time. This saves us much time in the meeting to focus on the kids! Becky Dorton, treasurer, presented the Annual Budget for the 2023-2024 school year. A copy of the budget is included below. She moved that, "the budget be approved as presented." McCall Cannon seconded the motion. The motion passed in unanimity. Becky also passed that, "The Annual Financial Reconciliation (AFR) be adopted as presented." Lori Willeitner and Kira Mildenstein both seconded the motion. The motion passed with unanimous consent as well.

Cynthia Cárdenas gave a principal report regarding the great things happening at Orchard. Cynthia shared that the teachers are doing great things, especially with the challenges they've been presented this year. She explained that there is a leadership team at the school comprised of one teacher per grade. They meet with her information between the principal and all teachers and vice-versa is shared via this leadership group. Several parents brought up concerns of short lunch/recess times (kids not having time to finish lunch or wash hands) and the lack of a second, scheduled recess. Concerns brought up included minimum DLI minutes to stay accredited, stress and anxiety of students, disagreements between students on the playground being reduced by not having a scheduled time for recess, teachers taking classes out on their own time, 6th graders working toward extra time outside if they can finish lunch in time, students getting 5 minutes more for eating lunch, some teachers opting for other activities within their classroom vs. going out for recess, etc. A lot of concerns on both sides were shared.

Folklórico Club started on August 28. EJ Caceres, Amber Blackett and Flora Aleman are working with a few teachers to plan and carry this out. Anyone interested in helping is absolutely welcome! Please reach out to Amber at president@orchardpta.org if you have any questions!

Health Night is September 29. This is a one-stop-FREE-shop. We have many different organizations coming to one place to help answer questions regarding children's health. It is a free event for all.

Reflections will be due on October 5. Marie McBride is coordinating reflections this year. She went to each class to invite students to participate. All entries are turned in online.
