DESCRIPTIONS OF PTA SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES

• CARNIVAL: This is tremendously important to our PTA. The more help, the better we do! Assist with ticket sales, find event sponsors for auction items, setup class donations contest, setup & assist with game stations, food, auctions, etc.
