Guardianship Associates Pro Se Training

Wednesday, May 7, 2014, 6:30 - 8:30 p.m.

During this training session GAU staff will teach the petitioner/guardian how to act as their own attorney (Pro Se) in a guardianship proceeding. We will answer any questions you might have regarding this process. Petitioners will be provided with a CD of documents that the courts require to be filed in a guardianship proceeding. Petitioners will also receive oral and written instructions detailing the process of completing the documents, filing your case and representing yourself in the actual guardianship hearing. The training session lasts approximately 2 hours. There is no cost associated with this training due to a grant from Utah State University. If you choose to use one of the attorneys that works with GAU to represent the ward, payment for their services is due at the time of the training. Cost for ward representation is from \$300.00 to \$450.00 depending on where you live in the state. Once you have signed up for this training an email with more detailed information will be sent to you 1-2 weeks prior to the training.
