Curriculum

<p>I can use various text features to identify the main topic and key details in an informational text.</p> <p>I will advance my fall reading level by at least one full grade level.</p> <p>I can summarize a story, after reading, using important characters, events and details in sequence.</p> <p>I can use a variety of strategies to decode words.</p> <p>I can write in different genres, using rubrics to guide my writing.</p> <p>I can identify and correct mistakes in my writing (punctuation, capitalization, etc.)</p> <p>I can use a variety of strategies to spell words correctly.</p> <p>I can write, in my own words, a summary of the important details of a text.</p>	<p>I can use place value correctly.</p> <p>I can add within thousands.</p> <p>I can subtract within thousands.</p> <p>I can fluently multiply numbers up to 10×10.</p> <p>I can fluently divide numbers up to $100 \div 10$.</p> <p>I can solve a variety of word problems.</p> <p>I can understand, compare and solve fraction problems.</p> <p>I can tell time to the nearest minute.</p>
