Mapped out how we would intergrade Social Studies and mapped out writing

4<sup>th</sup> grade writing has completely changed.

New chart form: 4 squares for their writing project, this has really helped the students structure their writing

Grammar has been a huge issue. We were able to take time to go through the grammar and to help it get incorporated. Chart was made of what  $4^{th}$  grade is going to teach each week

Social Studies - we found resources for activities and art to help teach this subject. Stem added the A to make it Steam. A is for Art.

Teacher demonstration of Chrome books:

Interim Sage test was given on chrome books it was an easy transition for the live sage testing. Chrome books are checked out every day. Teachers and students love them. IXL program is wonderful 120 licenses. Thank you, SCC, for supporting this program and for the chrome books.

Anna Steadman: The best money that the SCC council can spend is to invest in the teachers. Giving them collaboration time so they can plan together.

MV cluster wants to focus on 1st grade 6  $\frac{1}{2}$  day trainings next year. Training will be collaboration with literacy coach, school principal and 1<sup>st</sup> grade teacher's. This will be a year long process.
