Pony Express, kindergarten through third grade teams, will have a 5% increase in the composite benchmark score of the Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills (DIBELS) Test, from the 2018-2019 Middle of the year test (MOY) to the 2019-2020 MOY test.
