SUMMARY OF 2014 – 2015 PLAN**

Ridgeline received \$61,195 from Utah School Land Trust. We are grateful for these funds from the state to be used for our school's needs. The School Community Council approved how this money was to be spent. We thank these good people who serve on the council and help with these decisions.

This money was used to provide the following to help improve instruction for our students:

Approximate Cost

| \$27,000 | An aides in each of our kindergarten classrooms.   |
| \$9,000  | Extended-day kindergarten, 100 days of one hour extra instruction for about 30 struggling kindergarteners.   |
| \$5,600  | Double dose aides (with the help of a matching grant) to provide a before and after school program to help 1 <sup>st</sup> and 2 <sup>nd</sup> grades in reading and 4 <sup>th</sup> and 5 <sup>th</sup> grade in math . |
| \$5,700  | Aides for one hour a day to help in grades 4 through 6 to assist with math instructions and tracking student progress.   |
| \$9,000  | One set of 40 chromebooks (similar to a computer) and cart. These books were purchased using Trust Land money and other school funds.  |
| \$1,870  | Teachers received training in helping them in classroom instruction.   |
| \$3,025  | Carryover will be used for technology.   |

Our students have done very well in the year-end testing. We continue to improve and work on areas that need extra help. The added emphasis in helping our lower grade classes has helped get these students off to a great start with their education.
