School Updates:

Trust Lands has been instrumental in hiring aides and acquiring technology for the students.

Ridgeline has been awarded the 21st Century Grant. This grant will provide 1 technology device for every 2 students. The Beverly Taylor Sorensen Grant For the Arts will provide training and instruction for the arts

Fire damage is estimated at \$130,000 - \$170,000. Alpine School District's response to the damage was swift and thorough. Insurance has allotted \$7,950 to replace items lost in the fire. Juveniles have come forward to pay restitution. Principal, Dr. Ken Higgins, will be meeting with the attorneys representing those involved in October. Take Home Reading replacement will cost an estimated \$5,000-7,000.
