The 411 on PTA



What is the PTA? What does our PTA do?

PTA stands for Parent Teacher Association. At Sage Hills, our purpose is to do all we can to support our teachers, enrich our students' education, and bring our community together with a variety of fun and educational activities. We also support the school by finding volunteers for room parents, health/vision screenings, school pictures, book fairs, and other events.

How do I get updates on PTA events?

Do I have to join the PTA to help?

Certainly not. Anyone is welcome to become an official PTA member by paying a \$5 membership fee, but only board members are required to do so. As most of this fee goes to state and national PTA rather than our school, our favorite way for you to "join" is to volunteer! The back of this handout includes a list of ways we could use your help.

I want to help but I don't have a lot of time.

Many of our activities only involve a few hours of time commitment. If you are interested in helping, just let us know your interests and your constraints, and we'll help you find something that works for you.

How are the PTA's funds used?

PTA's funds come from one annual fundraiser and from Boxtops. This money is carefully budgeted at the beginning of the year to cover the expense of our activities as well as administrative costs (ex. paper for fliers). We work hard to make our events free or as low-cost as possible. Any event fees (ex. play tickets, choir fees, or Hogwarts meals) go to cover the cost of the events themselves. Leftover money from any events go to our teachers for field trips and other grade-level activities.
