Sage Hills Reading Scores

Each Fall, Winter, and Spring teachers at Sage Hills administer the Developmental Reading Assessment (DRA) to students. This test helps teachers to identify the level at which students are at and to help guide their reading instruction throughout the year. As part of our school improvement plan we had the goal to raise our Winter DRA scores by 5% from last year. We are excited to report that with the hard work from our teachers and students our DRA scores rose by 13% from last year. Because of this increase, and the level of our scores, our school does not qualify for the Summer Stars Reading program this year. This has been a great program and it will be missed. However, by not having the program it shows the reading improvements that our students are making.
