Dear Parents of Fifth-Grade Students,

Clear Creek Summer Camp is an outdoor education tradition that celebrates 53 years of amazing outdoor conservation, nature appreciation, science connection, and team-building experience for 5th-grade students. Now it's time to start thinking about registration.

Clear Creek Summer Camp is offered to students the summer after their fifth-grade school year. This two-day (no overnight) experience will consist of a day at the old Valley View Elementary and Anderson Park in Pleasant Grove from 8:00 - 2:30. The second day, 7:00 am - 7:30 pm, students will arrive at Valley View Elementary and travel to Alpine School District's Clear Creek nature campus by bus. Students will receive first-hand introductions to the forest and range environments, wildlife, geology, local history, and ecology of the area. In addition to the outdoor educational activities, they play games, complete ropes course team challenges, make crafts, learn songs, hike, and explore.

The facility is nestled in the canyons of the Manti-LaSal forest just south of the historic mining town of Scofield in Carbon County. A team of 6 certified Alpine School District teachers directs the instruction at Clear Creek Summer Camp each week. These educators are well-trained in our outdoor curriculum and committed to offering your child an unforgettable learning experience. High school-age camp counselors assist these teachers in making the week memorable and fun.

Registration fee pays for:

- Clear Creek t-shirt, camp book, craft materials
- Bus transportation to and from camp (departing from Valley View Elementary School)
