Sego Lily and Regular Education Busing

After review by the Transportation Department and Alpine School District Administration at the completion of the 900 North project, it has been determined there will no longer be regular education busing for Sego Lily Elementary.

The state transportation funding guidelines require that elementary students live at least 1.5 miles from the school in order to be eligible for transportation.

As the entire Sego Lily bus route is within 1.5 miles of the school per the state and district measurement guidelines (as listed below), the Board of Education previously used local funds to transport students in your area due to lack of a safe walking route.

Per the state funding guidelines, we determine the distance from home to school as follows: From the center of the public route (road, thoroughfare, walkway, or highway) open to public use, opposite the regular entrance of the one where the pupil is living, over the nearest public route (thoroughfare, road, walkway, or highway) open regularly for use by the public, to the center of the public route (thoroughfare, road, walkway, or highway) open to public use, opposite the nearest public entrance to the school grounds which the student is attending (Utah Rule 277-600-4-F; District Policy Rule 3120).

For clarification 1) it may not start at your front door or driveway 2) the nearest public entrance to school grounds may not be the front door or loading zone of the school and 3) we are required to measure according to the closest public access route regardless of walkability.

If your child will be walking or biking to school, we encourage you to work with your school and school community council to determine a safe walking/biking route.
