PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

When used appropriately, I believe technology can help tremendously in our quest to improve learning for all students at Traverse Mountain Elementary. We are looking forward to some great improvements and partnerships regarding how we use technology at our school. First, thank you for supporting our iPad Fundraiser. Also, many employers have donation programs and we would love to partner with them in this great cause.

Many of you may be aware that our school was selected at the end of last year by the state as a grant pilot for iPad technology. We have integrated this grant into one classroom and our special education department. We are continually amazed at the results as students are engaged in learning activities. Another school in Auburn, Maine completed a study using iPads in half of their schools' kindergarten classes. Following are quotes from that study:

"According to the literacy test results, classes using the iPads outperformed the non-iPad students in every literacy measure they were tested on. It's not just about the test scores, but about the way the kids interact with the iPad and apps that make this program unique. We are seeing high levels of student motivation, engagement and learning in the iPad

classrooms,' said Sue Dorris, principal at East Auburn Community School. 'The apps, which teach and reinforce fundamental literacy concepts and skills, are engaging, interactive and provide children with immediate feedback. What's more, teachers can customize apps to match the instructional needs of each child, so students are able to learn successfully at their own level and pace."'

We look forward to keeping everyone informed as we enhance our teaching with technology that will motivate and engage students in learning.

March is National Nutrition Month. We can use this month to re-evaluate the foods that we eat and the nutrition basics that we teach our children. Did you know that the government supports a new nutritional guideline? The new "MyPlate" replaces the food pyramid, gives more emphasis to fruits and vegetables and shows a visual representation of the balance of foods we should put on our plates and into our lives. One way to help our kids really learn about nutritional choices is to bring them into the kitchen - let them help plan for, shop for, and cook the meal. When kids are apart of the food creation process they are more willing to try new things and eat healthy foods.
