Dear Traverse Mountain Community



Student Handbook Highlight

Pets: Pets should not be brought to school unless arrangements have been made with the teacher. Please be mindful of students with allergies. Parents should accompany the pet to school and take it home after it has been shown.

Inside Days

We keep students inside if the temperature outside is 20 degrees or less. This includes wind chill. We also keep children inside if the air quality is in the "unhealthy" range according to air.utah.gov. We include in our monitoring the air quality reading of an independent unit installed at a home in Traverse Mountain. Students who are tagged in Skyward as having respiratory problems, or asthma, are kept inside when the air quality is "unhealthy for sensitive groups." Parents who wish for students to be kept inside outside these guidelines will need to write a daily note to their child's teacher.
